JIM FOR 20 YEARS HAS GONE ABOVE AND BEYOND THE LINE OF DUTY IN MAKING SURE WE HAVE CLEAN AND SAFE WATER TO DRINK AS WELL AS KEEPING OUR SEWER PLANT RUNNING AT ALL TIMES. WE THANK HIM FOR HIS DEDICATED SERVICE AND APPRECIATE EVERYTHING HE HAS DONE FOR US.

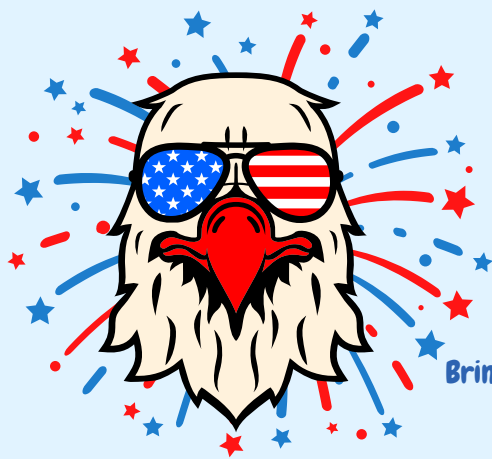

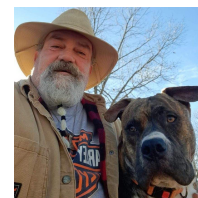
